JUST A FEW AYAT OF THE ATTRIBUTES / KNOWLEDGE OF ALLAH MENTIONED IN AL-OUR'AN:

- 1) Al-Qur'an:2-29. "[...] and of all things He hath perfect knowledge."
- 2) Al-Qur'an:2-235. "[...] **Allah knoweth what is in your hearts,** and take heed of Him ; and know that Allah is Oft-forgiving, Most Forbearing."
- 3) Al-Qur'an:3-5. "From Allah, verily nothing is hidden on earth or in the heavens."
- 4) Al-Qur'an:6-38. "There is not an animal (that lives) on the earth or a being that flies on its wings, but (forms part of) communities like you. **Nothing have We** omitted from the Book, and they (all) shall be gathered to their Rabb in the end."
- 5) Al-Qur'an:6-59. "With Him are the keys of the unseen, the treasures that none knoweth but He. He knoweth whatever there is on the earth and in the sea. Not a leaf doth fall but with His knowledge: there is not a grain in the darkness (or depths) of the earth, nor anything fresh or dry (green or withered), but is (inscribed) in a record clear."
- 6) Al-Qur'an:6-60. "It is He who doth take your consciousness by night, and hath knowledge of all that ye have done by day: by day doth He raise you up again; that a term appointed be fulfilled; in the end unto Him will be your return; then will He show you the truth of all that ye did."
- 7) Al-Qur'an:6-101. "To Him is due the primal origin of the heavens and the earth: how can He have a son when He hath no consort? He created all things, and He hath full knowledge of all things."
- 8) Al-Qur'an:7-7. "And verily, We shall recount their whole story with knowledge, for **We** were never absent (at any time or place)."
- 9) Al-Qur'an:8-24. "[...] and know that Allah cometh in between a man and his heart, and that it is He to whom ye shall (all) be gathered."
- 10) Al-Qur'an:9-39. "[...] For Allah hath power over all things."
- 11) Qur'an:10-61. "In whatever business thou mayest be, and whatever portion thou mayest be reciting from the Qur'an, and whatever deed ye (mankind) may be doing, We are witnesses thereof when ye are deeply engrossed therein. Nor is hidden from thy Rabb (so much as) the weight of an atom on the earth or in heaven. And not the least and not the greatest of these things but are recorded in a Clear Record."
- 12) Al-Qur'an:11-112. "Therefore stand firm (in the straight Path-Al-Qur'an) as thou (Muhammad) art commanded, thou (Muhammad) and those who with thee turn (unto Allah); and transgress not (from the Path of Al-Qur'an): for He seeth well all that ye do."
- 13) Al-Qur'an:13-33. "Is then He who standeth over every nafs (and knoweth) all that it doth, (like any others)?"
- 14) Al-Qur'an:19-64. "[...] and thy Rabb never doth forget,"-

- 15) Qur'an:20-7. "If thou pronounce the word aloud, (it is no matter): for verily He and what is yet more hidden." knoweth what is secret
- 16) Al-Qur'an:20-52. Musa said: "[...] the knowledge of that is with my Rabb, duly recorded: my Rabb never errs, nor forgets,"-
- 17) Al-Qur'an:21-4. "Say: "my Rabb knoweth (every) word (spoken) in the heavens and on earth: He is the one that heareth and knoweth (all things)."
- 18) Al-Qur'an:21-110. "It is He who knows what is open in speech and what ye hide (in your hearts)."
- 19) Qur'an:27-74. "And verily thy Rabb knoweth all that their hearts do hide. As well as all that they reveal."
- 20) Al-Qur'an:28-69. "And thy Rabb knows all that their hearts conceal and all that they reveal."
- 21) Al-Qur'an:29-60. "How many are the creatures that carry not their own sustenance? It is Allah who feeds (both) them and you: for He hears and knows (all things)."
- 22) Al-Qur'an:29-62. "Allah enlarges the sustenance (which He gives) to whichever of His servants He pleases; and He (similarly) grants by (strict) measure, (as He pleases): for **Allah has full knowledge of all things."**
- 23) Al-Qur'an:31-30. **"That is because Allah is the (only) Reality,** and because whatever else they invoke besides Him is falsehood; and because Allah, He is the Most High, Most great."
- 24) Al-Qur'an:33-54. "Whether ye reveal anything or conceal it, verily Allah has full knowledge of all things."
- 25) Al-Qur'an:34-3. "[...] by Him who knows the unseen,- from whom is not hidden the least little atom in the heavens or on earth: nor is there anything less than that, or greater, but is in the record Perspicuous:"
- 26) Al-Qur'an:35-8. "[...] for Allah knows well all that they do!"
- 27) Al-Qur'an:39-62. "Allah is the Creator of all things, and He affairs." is the guardian and disposer of all
- 28) Al-Qur'an:39-67. "No just estimate have they made of Allah, such as is due to Him : on the Day of Judgment the whole of the earth will be but His handful, and the heavens will be rolled up in His right hand: glory to Him! High is He above the partners they attribute to Him!"
- 29) Al-Qur'an:42-11. "(He is) the Creator of the heavens and the earth: He among yourselves, and pairs among cattle: by this means does He whatever like unto Him, and He is the one that hears and sees (all things)."
- 30) Al-Qur'an:49-18. "Verily Allah knows the secrets of the heavens and the earth: and Allah sees well all that ye do."

- 31) Al-Qur'an:50-4. "We already know how much of them the earth takes away: with Us is a record guarding (the full account)."
- **32**) Al-Qur'an:50-16. "It was We who created man, and We know what dark suggestions his nafs makes to him: **for We** are nearer to him than (his) jugular vein."
- 33) Al-Qur'an:57-3. "He is the first and the last, the evident and the Immanent: and He has full knowledge of all things."
- 34) Al-Qur'an:57-4. "He it is who created the heavens and the earth in six periods, and is moreover firmly established on the Throne (of authority). He knows what enters within the earth and what comes forth out of it, what comes down from heaven and what mounts up to it. And He is with you wheresoever ye may be. And Allah sees well all that ye do."
- 35) Al-Qur'an:58-7. "Seest thou not that Allah doth know (all) that is in the heavens and on earth? There is not a secret consultation between three, but He makes the fourth among them, nor between five but He makes the sixth, nor between fewer nor more, but He is in their midst, wheresoever they be: in the end will He tell them the truth of their conduct, on the Day of Judgment. For Allah has full knowledge of all things."
- 36) Al-Qur'an:59-22. "Allah is He, than whom there is no other god; who knows (all things) both secret and open; He , Most Gracious, Most Merciful."
- 37) Al-Qur'an:59-23. "Allah is He, than whom there is no other god; the Sovereign, the Holy one, the Source of Peace (and Perfection), the Guardian of Faith, the Preserver of Safety, the Exalted in Might, the Irresistible, the Supreme: Glory to Allah. (High is He) above the partners they attribute to Him."
- 38) Al-Qur'an:59-24. "He is Allah, the Creator, the Evolver, the Bestower of Forms (or colours). To Him belong the Most beautiful names: whatever is in the heavens and on earth, doth declare His praises and glory: and He is the Exalted in Might, the Wise."
- 39) Al-Qur'an:84-15. "[...] for His Rabb was (ever) watchful of him!"
- 40) Al- Qur'an:21-30. "Do not the unbelievers see that the heavens and the earth were joined together (as one unit of creation), before We clove them asunder? We made from water every Living thing. Will they not then believe?"

(This ayah (21-30) clearly informs us that Allah is independent/outside of His creation and can NEVER be within the creation!}
